### IV. <u>AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION</u>

Local artist, T.J. Morgan, local artist presented an image of a large scale sculpture to the Commission. Mr. Morgan was interested in the Sculpture Garden program and was also interested in a grant for his project. The work entitled "Creation" is a tribute to Manhattan Beach as the volleyball capital. The piece will be placed on the beach and stands three stories high. The Commission appreciated the opportunity to view the sculpture; however, the designated sites for the Sculpture Garden do not include areas on the beach.

The Commission will work on guidelines for the Sculpture Garden program and, once completed, the guidelines will be added to the City website.
