

Traffic Study does not include adequate portions of Rosecrans east bound towards 405

Traffic Study and EIR based on improvements in all 3 Phases

- Virtually all Traffic happens with First Phase.
- All Traffic Improvements come years later in Phase 2 and Phase 3.
- Phases 2 and 3 may never be built.



Construction Parking

There is none. Where will the cars park?

Construction Traffic Management Plan CTMP

CTMP is only required if construction extend into November and December.

Who allows a project to start in a congested mall without a parking plan?

Parking will impact all existing Mall businesses and sale tax revenues.

Project Alternatives in EIR

- Alternative A Build Nothing Rejected
- Alternative B Build Phase One Only
 - Rejected as Socially Infeasible
 - Does not incorporate Fry's corner
 - Does not enhance spatial relationships
 - Does not promote pedestrian access
- Alternative C Phase One in front of Ralphs
 - Rejected
- Alternative D Environmentally Superior
 - None found
- Real Alternatives Not Studied

Unstudied Alternatives

- Smaller Project Alternative
 - Underground garage on Fry's corner
 - Aboveground garage by Macy's
 - No Impacts on existing Mall sales volumes
 - Moves Parking lot lights away from Oak Avenue
 - Requires traffic improvements up front
 - Insures Project is completed as planned
 - Has Community Support
