SUBJECT: Authorize the Purchase of Two Replacement Police Vehicles from Cerritos Nissan

in the Amount of \$50,925.26

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council award of RFB #708-07 to Cerritos Nissan in the amount of \$50,925.26 for the budgeted replacement of two Police Detective vehicles.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

Funds totaling \$68,000 are budgeted in the FY 2006-2007 Fleet Management Fund for the purchase and equipping of these vehicles. The total cost of the vehicles is \$50,925.26. The remaining funds will be used to outfit the vehicles with the usual necessary equipment (lighting, racks, etc.).

BACKGROUND:

During the FY 2006-2007 Budget process, Council authorized the replacement of these two detective vehicles. The replacement of a detective vehicle is based on several factors including mileage, age, reliability, and maintenance costs. The first vehicle is a replacement for unit #119, a 1993 Pontiac Bonneville with 99,637 miles. The second vehicle will replace unit #122, which is a 1998 Olds Intrigue with 76,589 miles.

DISCUSSION:

Staff sent bid requests to seven vendors and three responses were received. The comparison below shows the total price (including sales tax, discounts, and other fees).

Based on these bids, staff recommends awarding to the lowest bidder, Cerritos Nissan, for the

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purchase of two undercover investigation units in the amount of \$50,925.26. If this purchase is approved, the existing vehicles will be surplused and auctioned for the highest attainable value. The new vehicles will arrive in 1-3 weeks.
