## **BACKGROUND:**

On January 7, 2014, the City Council gave the Parks and Recreation Commission permission to proceed in researching the feasibility of developing a skateboard park in the City of Manhattan Beach. The Commission has formed and Ad-Hoc Committee to research and discuss funding options, location, design, usage control, operations.
