Dear Resident,

The Manhattan Beach Parks and Recreation Commission has recently discussed the feasibility of developing a skateboard park in the City of Manhattan Beach. Part of this process is determining the potential locations within the City where a skateboard park could be developed.

It is important to the City and the Parks and Recreation Commission that your comments and neighborhood considerations are heard. We want to know what you think. The Parks and Recreation Commission Skateboard Park Ad-Hoc Committee has been meeting to address and gather input and information regarding the feasibility and desirability of a skateboard park, and created a list of potential skateboard park locations and site selection criteria. This list was presented to the Parks and Recreation Commission. Based on the site selection criteria, the Parks and Recreation Commission selected the following sites as potential locations for a skateboard park:

Marine Avenue Park – 1625 Marine Avenue – two locations

Marine Sports Complex – 1751 Marine Avenue – one location
