# Department Overview

- ▶ The Information Technology Department provides the following services to internal and external users:
  - Network Infrastructure and Security
  - Hardware (workstations, smartphones, tablets, printers)
  - Operating Systems

  - City website and telecommunications systems
  - Webcast and cable broadcasts
  - Geographic Information Systems (GIS)



## **FY 2014-2015 Accomplishments**

- ▶ Presented update on City's 2013 Information Systems Master Plan (ISMP)
- ▶ Performed upgrades and enhancements to City's network infrastructure; increased bandwidth to Internet
- ▶ Enhanced efforts to connect with citizens through online civic engagement, social media, mobile apps and online geospatial mapping

## **FY 2014-2015 Accomplishments**

- ▶ Enhanced and expanded City's broadcast capability at remote facilities
- ▶ Added closed captioning on webcasts
- ▶ Mobility and remote network access for management
- ▶ Security surveillance at Police Department and new surveillance at City Hall
- ▶ SCADA Infrastructure Upgrades
