RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

On August 20, 2002, Council approved the MBPD Community Police Academy. On September 8, 2005, the fifth class began. Seventeen members of the community were selected and have participated in ten lectures and one police ride along.

During their ten week experience the Community Police Academy has

- Provided the participants with knowledge of our Department, what we do, and how we do it.
- Enhanced communications between the police and the participants and improved the level of understanding of the role each plays in public safety.
- Allowed participants to experience hands-on exercises relating to the duties, services and responsibilities of policing.

Additionally, the participants were provided a forum for their questions so that their concerns were addressed.
