WHEREAS, the Parish began with masses being celebrated in the homes of parishioners, until Father Leo Lambrick, the first Pastor, built the original American Martyrs Catholic Church on Fourth Street; and

WHEREAS, through the vision of Monsignor Edmund O'Donnell, in 1954, the present church property, on 15th Street, was purchased and a new school and church were built; and

WHEREAS, on Easter Sunday, 1957, the first Mass was celebrated in the new church; thus began this journey of faith in "The House on the Side of the Road"; and

WHEREAS, today, American Martyrs is home to a vibrant, highly acclaimed Catholic school, educating students from throughout the South Bay; and

WHEREAS, under the guidance of its lay leadership and its pastor, Monsignor John F. Barry, American Martyrs Catholic Church has grown to almost 6,000 registered families, many of whom are actively involved in the more than 60 ministries that serve the South Bay community and beyond.
