#### **DISCUSSION:**

### The Strand Improvement Project

The Contractor has completed 18% of the construction contract. Work accomplished since the last progress payment includes installation of PVC storm drain pipe and electrical conduit within Phase II (28<sup>th</sup> Street to 36<sup>th</sup> Street) of the project.

The Contractor is currently pouring the westerly concrete curb within Phase II of the project.

The Contractor has submitted a request for Progress Payment No. 6 in the net amount of \$32,377.37. All work items covered by this payment have been reviewed by the Public Works Department and found to be in conformance with the plans and specifications.

## Highland Avenue at 15th Place Storm Drain Project

The Contractor has completed 25% of the construction contract. Work accomplished includes saw-cutting and removal of the existing pavement, trench excavation and installation of 365 linear feet of new 24" reinforced concrete storm drain pipe on Ocean Drive from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Place. In addition, the Contractor has constructed and connected various substructures to the main storm drain pipeline; including, three catch basins and two manhole connections. The Contractor has also constructed the base course of asphalt concrete paving along Ocean Drive from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Place.

The Contractor is currently continuing the construction of the new storm drain pipeline along 16<sup>th</sup> Place from Ocean Drive to Highland Avenue

The Contractor has submitted a request for Progress Payment No. 1 in the net amount of \$122,160.60. All work items covered by this payment have been reviewed by the Public Works Department and found to be in conformance with the plans and specifications.
