SUBJECT: Consideration of Appointment of Jean Cordero to the South Bay Workforce

Investment Board

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council appoint Jean Cordero to serve as the Manhattan Beach representative to the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) for the term of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2009.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

There are no budget implications associated with staff's recommendation.

DISCUSSION:

The South Bay Workforce Investment Board administers and delivers services pursuant to the Federal Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) to the residents of El Segundo, Gardena, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Inglewood, Lawndale, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach. Each city has a "private-sector employer" that serves as our representative on the SBWIB.

Jean Cordero, owner of Entertaining Friends is being nominated by the Chamber of Commerce for the term of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2009. Jean meets the requirements of the SBWIB and is therefore an appropriate representative.

If the City Council approves the request, the appointment will be presented to the City of Hawthorne City council for ratification. The City of Hawthorne is designated as the agency responsible for administering the SBWIB.
