Sensible Citizens of Manhattan Beach sued the City, alleging that the City did not comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in approving the project. On November 2, 2016, Los Angeles Superior Court (Hon. Amy D. Hogue) ruled that the City fully complied with CEQA in reviewing the project.

b) Name of Case:

The Dentist's Insurance Company v. City of Manhattan Beach Los Angeles County Superior Court

Case Number: BC 636930

Plaintiff claims that on March 17, 2016, property located at 1213 Manhattan Beach (sic) Avenue was allegedly damaged by sewage from a City-owned sewer line.
