Entry Rules:

- Artists of all ages who are Manhattan Beach residents, students attending a Manhattan Beach school, or enrolled in a Manhattan Beach Parks and Recreation art class can participate.
- Limit 1 submission per artist.
- Artwork can be in any 2-dimensional medium, and no more than 2 ft. x 2 ft. in size.
- The exhibition theme is, “*What people love about Manhattan Beach,*” and submissions should reflect this theme.
- This will be a juried show.
- Submission of artwork does not guarantee that it will be physically exhibited at City Hall.
- All submissions will be displayed in digital format on the city’s website.
- **DEADLINE: January 24, 2017. Entries must be received by this date LATE WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

- Entry form (available at Manhattan Beach City Hall, Manhattan Beach Art Center, and Manhattan Beach City Website).
- JPEG image of the artwork (image named with artist name).

Please note, if selected to physically display your artwork, you will be notified to deliver your artwork Monday, February 13th – Tuesday, February 14th, during city hall hours 7:30 AM - 5:30 PM.

ENTRY RULES:

The exhibition theme is: **What people love about Manhattan Beach**, submissions should reflect this theme. The *Why I ❤️ MB* Exhibition will be held at **City Hall** and is open to artists of all ages who are Manhattan Beach resident, students attending a Manhattan Beach school, or enrolled in a Manhattan Beach Parks and Recreation art class. Artwork can be in any medium, must be 2 dimensional, and no more than 2 ft. x 2 ft. in size. There is a limit to only one submission per artist. Due to a restricted amount of space, not all entries will be physically displayed at City Hall (although, all entries will be featured in digital format on a T.V. at City Hall and the City Website).

How to Submit Your Work:

- To have your work featured, please complete this form and email it along with a JPEG image of your artwork (named with the artist's name) to: infombac@citymb.info. The art will be juried and artists will be notified on whether their piece will be showcased in physical or digital form at City Hall.
- If notified to showcase your art in physical form, please cut and attach the bottom portion titled, "ARTWORK ID" to your piece before delivering it to City Hall.
- **If notified, please drop off** your HANG READY* artwork to Manhattan Beach City Hall, February 13-14 (7:30 AM - 5:30 PM).
- **Please pick up** your artwork from Manhattan Beach City Hall, March 20-24 (M-Th 7:30 AM - 5:30 PM; Alt. F 8 AM - 5 PM). All artwork not picked up by March 24th at 5 PM will be moved to MBAC for storage for a maximum of 60 days.
