- All submissions will be displayed in digital format on the city's website.

- Please pick up your artwork from Manhattan Beach City Hall, March 20-24 (M-Th 7:30 AM 5:30 PM; Alt. F 8 AM 5 PM). All artwork not picked up by March 24th at 5 PM will be moved to MBAC for storage for a maximum of 60 days.
