-City Council Meeting discussed "Loop Project" with SCE SC Gas, consisting of a 20" Natural Gas pipeline under Rosecrans to back up the existing 36" pipeline currently under El Segundo Blvd which was originally installed in the 1930's. State regulators and City Council calling for system updates prior to granting approval for go ahead. City requesting upgrade to gas storage tank in Marina Del Rey

- -Fire Chief Espinosa and City Council working issues of Mutual Aid Agreement changes as Hermosa Beach FD may outsource service needs to L.A. County Fire.
- -City Council approved L.A. County combining/conducting city elections, single election in March saving city costs.
