## RECYCLE YOUR ELECTION MATERIALS

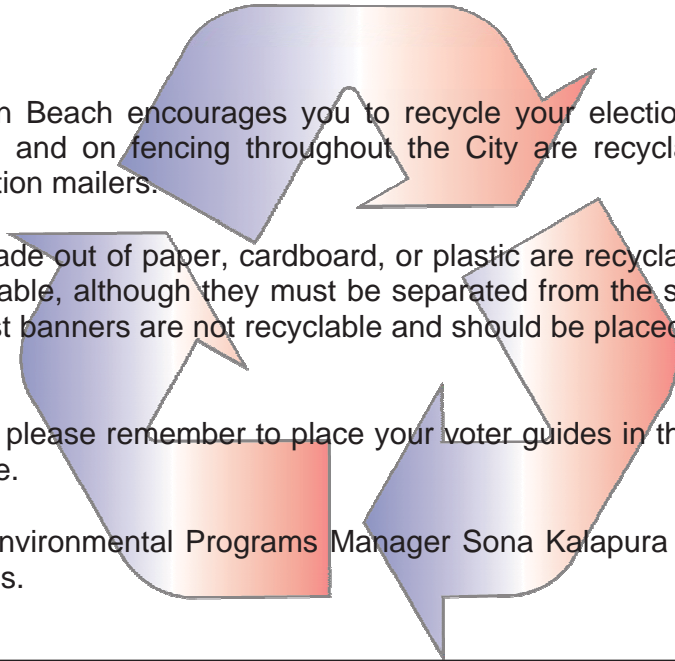
### *Political Mailers, Signs, and Posters are Recyclable*

The City of Manhattan Beach encourages you to recycle your election materials. Most political signs placed in yards and on fencing throughout the City are recyclable, as are official Voter Guides and other election mailers.

Signs and placards made out of paper, cardboard, or plastic are recyclable. The metal stakes and stands are also recyclable, although they must be separated from the sign before being placed in the recycling cart. Most banners are not recyclable and should be placed in the trash if they cannot be re-used.

Once you have voted, please remember to place your voter guides in the recycling bin, along with your campaign signage.

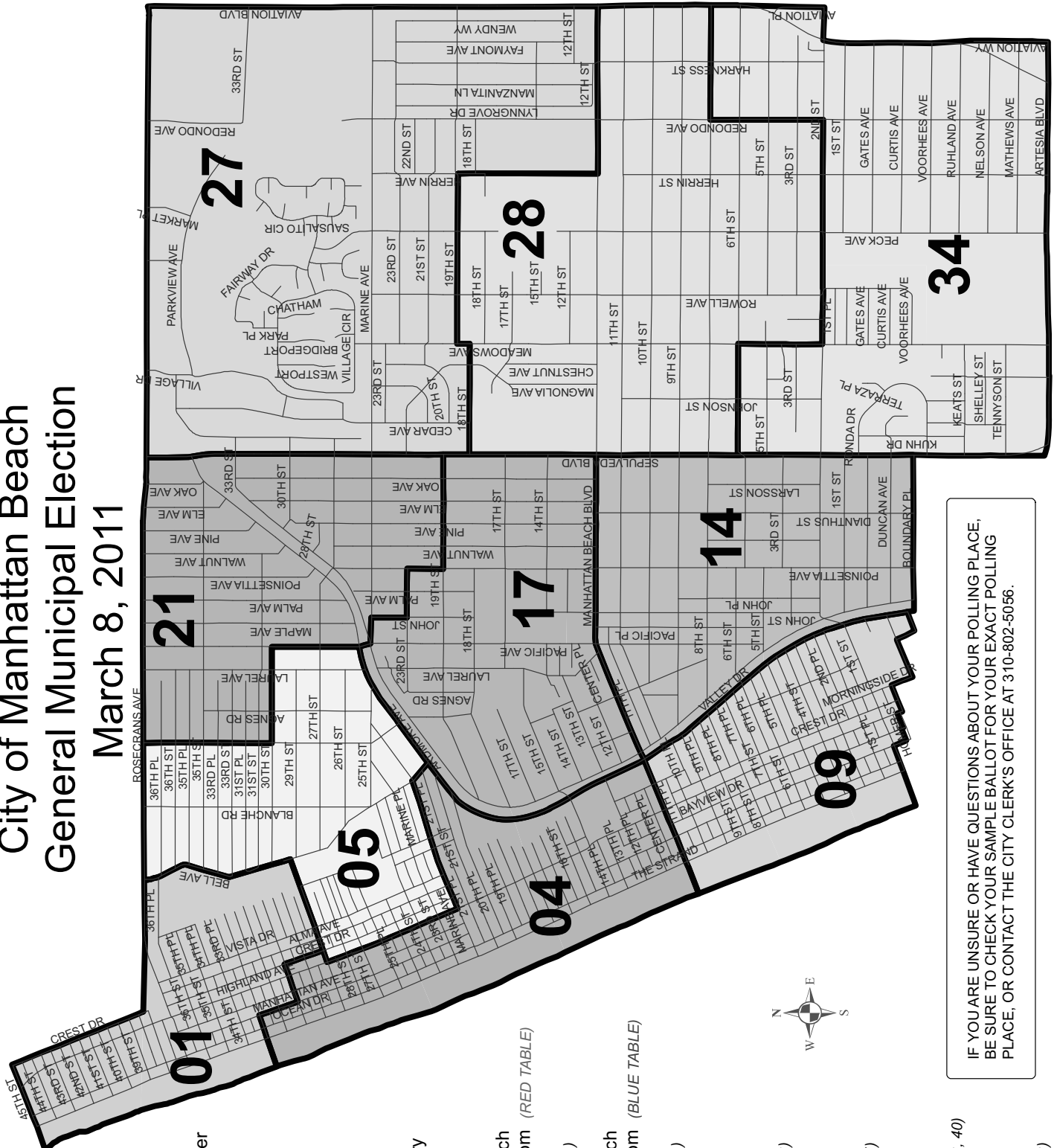

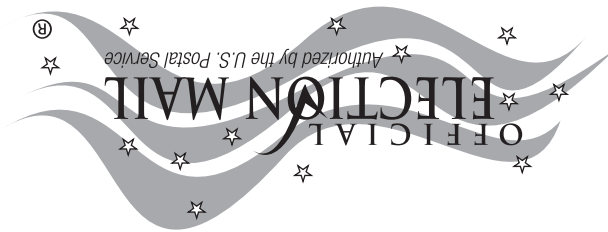

## NOTICE TO THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED VOTER:



If the polling place is not accessible to the physically handicapped voter, such voter is entitled to vote in one of the following ways:

1. A precinct board member shall take a regular ballot to the physically handicapped person at a place as near as possible to the polling place and which is accessible to such person, qualify that person to vote, and return the voted ballot to the polling place;
2. If it is impractical to vote a regular ballot outside the polling place, please use the attached application and apply for a vote by mail ballot.
