SUBJECT: Appoint Member to Library Commission Seat No. 4

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council pass a motion to APPOINT a member to the Library Commission Seat No. 4 (Wagner) or choose from among the two alternatives.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

None associated with this action.

BACKGROUND:

The Library Commission consists of five (5) members and serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council regarding library services provided by the Los Angeles County Library System to the Citizens of Manhattan Beach.

On December 28, 2004, the City Clerk's Office received a memo from Parks and Recreation Director Richard Gill and Recreation Services Manager Mark Leyman indicating that Chris Wagner, who holds Seat No. 4 on the Library Commission, has stepped down due to his inavailability to attend the Commission meetings.

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Wagner's term on the Library Commission, Seat No. 4, was scheduled to expire May 31, 2005. Per Ordinance No. 1975, if a vacant seat has 18 months or less remaining in its term, the new member would be appointed to complete the original term of office (expiring May 31, 2005) and then automatically be re-appointed to a three-year term without further ceremony. Following the three-year term, the member would be eligible for re-appointment by the City Council to one more three-year term.

ALTERNATIVES:

If Council chooses not to make an appointment tonight, Council may consider the following:

- 1) Direct staff to re-advertise this vacant Library Commission seat for appointment at the March 1, 2005 City Council meeting.
- 2) Normally, a Board or Commission vacancy would be filled immediately, however, because the yearly Board & Commission appointment cycle is so close, Council may choose to add this vacancy to the other Commission vacancies which will expire on May 31, 2005.

The Board and Commission interviews are currently scheduled to take place on April 26, 2005. Council appointments for all vacant Commission seats, expiring on May 31, 2005, will take place at the May 3, 2005 City Council meeting.
