Investment Portfolio for January 2019 SUBJECT:

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Finance Subcommittee accepts the status report on the City's investment portfolio as of January 31, 2019.

FISCAL IMPLICATION:

There are no fiscal implications associated with the recommended action. As of January 31, 2019, the City's investment portfolio totaled \$114.3 million in book value (\$114.7 million par value).

DISCUSSION:

Since the last update as of September 2018, the City's investment portfolio has increased \$8.0 million in par value due to a \$6.0 million net increase in investments (purchases less redemptions) and a \$2.0 million increase in investment in the Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF). Consistent with prior years, the receipt of Property Taxes in December and January significantly contributed to this increase. Overall, Property Taxes received during the months of December, January, April and May offset summer months when normal operating activities (warrants and payroll coverage) cause the City to operate at a deficit.

In October 2017, the City deposited \$750,000 into the PARS Pension Rate Stabilization Trust as approved by the City Council. This balance, plus the gains and losses received on the funds, is presented with each monthly Portfolio Report below the total Treasurer's Balance (page 10). At the time of posting the Finance Subcommittee's Agenda packet, the January 2019 statement had not been received. The January 2019 balance will be provided during the Finance Subcommittee's meeting.

Average Yield to Maturity on the City's portfolio book value increased to 2.150% in January from 1.986% in September. During this time frame, one corporate security, four government agency securities and one U.S. treasury security totaling \$10.0 million were purchased. Maturing securities included three government agency securities.

Market conditions and investment opportunities in accordance with the City's Investment Policy are monitored regularly. Efforts are made to ensure the portfolio is well-balanced for the safety of principal by investing in high-grade securities that are diversified in origin and maturity date.

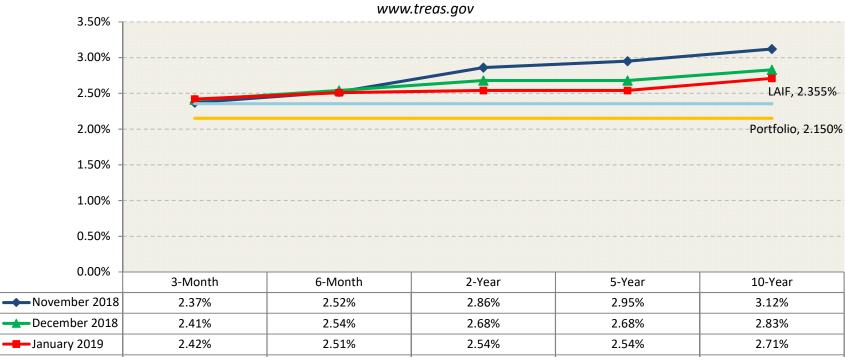

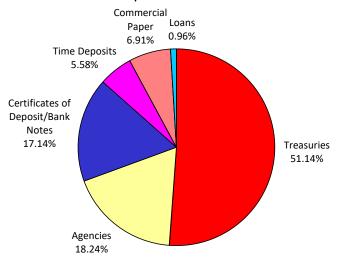
