

- Appeal- Coastal Defender




VICINITY MAP

- Major Interior Remodel/ Reconfiguration









PLANNING COMMISSION- 03/11/2020

- Concerns about Hours
 - Restaurant vs Bar
 - Floorplan



- New Conditions
 - No Alcohol Service After 12:00 a.m.
 - Windows Must Be Closed by 10:00 p.m.
 - One-Year Report to Planning Commission with Public Noticing



APPEAL

- Appellant: Coastal Defender March 21, 2020
- Noise
 - 25 Seats Next to Windows
 - Police Record: One Noise Call in 9 Years
 - Close All Windows by 10:00 p.m.
 - Live Entertainment is Prohibited
- ABC Rules
 - Already Operating with Type 47 License for 9 Years
 - No History of Disciplinary Action from ABC
 - Condition of Approval to Follow ABC's Rules



APPEAL

- Occupancy
 - Plan Check Process: Planning, Building & Safety, Fire, and Public Works
 - No Building Permits Will Be Issued without Compliance
- 1:00 a.m. Closing Time is a Policy Change
 - No Written Policy on Post-Midnight Closing Requirement
 - Use Permits Analyzed on Each Application's Unique Merits
 - Other Businesses' Entitlements Not Relevant to Request
 - Three Instances in Last 15 Years Where Post-Midnight Closing Times Were Left Unchanged



REQUIRED FINDINGS

- "Use is in accord with... the purposes of the district..."
- "Not be detrimental to the public health, safety or welfare of persons residing or working... in or adjacent to the neighborhood of such use..."
- "Proposed use will comply with... any specific condition required for the proposed use in the district in which it would be located."
- "...Will not adversely impact or be adversely impacted by nearby properties."
- Use is compatible with surrounding uses

REQUIRED FINDINGS

- Use is a Commercial Use in a Commercial Zone
- Neighboring Lots-Commercial/Restaurants
- Physical Barriers between Restaurant and Residential Neighbors
- One Noise Complaint in Nine Years of Operation
- Use is Compatible with Surrounding Commercial Uses
