CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- Recover MB Through "Safer at Home" efforts, the City of Manhattan Beach collectively slowed the spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19), allowing for a phased re-opening of some businesses and public spaces. In concert with the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health (DPH) revised <u>Public Health Order</u> new standards for re-opening aligned with the State of California guidelines, the City has launched the <u>RECOVER MB</u> webpage. At a glance, website viewers can quickly find information on what's currently open, closed for now, re-opening timeline, and re-opening protocols.
