Waste Management to begin billing for Refuse Services on July 1, 2020



2020 Commercial Program and Service Enhancements

Dear Valued Customer:

Effective July 1, 2020, Manhattan Beach commercial customers will be billed by Waste Management directly, offering one point of contact for both customer service and billing. Manhattan Beach commercial customers will receive their final bill from the City of Manhattan Beach for Refuse Services in June, which will cover service through June 30, 2020. Commercial customers will receive their first bill from Waste Management in July for services provided in July. Manhattan Beach commercial customers will then continue to receive a trash bill from Waste Management on the last day of each month for the prior month's service.

The following Service Changes will begin July 1, 2020, as part of your already exceptional service and programs:

- Commercial Recycling (glass/paper/metal/plastic) will be offered at discounted rates (no longer free service)
- View page 2 of this letter to learn about changes to plastics recycling
- Commercial Food Waste Recycling will continue to be provided at no additional charge
- Ongoing site visits for non-compliant businesses subject to AB 341 and AB 1826
- Establishment of Downtown Maintenance Enhancement Plan Working Group- will meet on a quarterly basis


Below is an example of what the current City of Manhattan Beach Commercial Refuse Bill looks like and what the **NEW** Waste Management bill will look like:

Changes to Recycling



Beginning July 1, 2020







in BLUE RECYCLING CART & WHITE RECYCLING BIN BEGINNING JULY 1, 2020

Recycling must be CLEAN, DRY & LOOSE (NOT BAGGED)!

- clean & dry PAPER
- clean & dry METAL
- clean & dry GLASS
- ONLY clean & dry PLASTICS # 1, 2 & 5

EXAMPLES OF PLASTICS # 1, 2 & 5



Beverage bottles (water, soda, energy drinks), peanut butter jars, salad dressing bottles, etc.



Clear milk jugs, detergent bottles, bleach bottles, shampoo and conditioner bottles, plastic crates, plastic carts, lawn chairs, laundry baskets, etc.



Tupper ware, yogurt containers, margarine tubs and other refrigerated containers, bottle tops, etc.

UNACCEPTED



Plastics # 3, 4, 6 & 7 will go into the landfill trash cart & bin. Try to avoid these plastics & when possible, reuse or donate!

EXAMPLES OF PLASTICS # 3, 4, 6 & 7



Food wrap, tile, PVC plumbing pipes, window frames, etc.



Grocery bags, shrink/cling wrap, garment bags, frozen food bags, sandwich bags, etc.



Throwaway utensils, meat packing, protective packing, Styrofoam insulation, packing peanuts, etc.



Plastic CDs/DVDs, baby bottles, eye glasses, exterior lighting fixtures, etc.
