COVID-19 CASE COUNT

OCTOBER 26, 2020

The City of Manhattan Beach remains committed to providing the community with critical information and updates on the COVID-19 pandemic. The COVID-19 Situation Reports are published twice-a-week on Tuesdays and Thursdays and supplements the Situation Reports with coronavirus case counts (latest numbers) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to keep the community informed.

The change reflects daily increases, not increases from the prior situation report. The number of new deaths and cases reported reflects a lag from reports over the weekend.

As of October 20, 2020, [Los Angeles County remains in Tier One](#), with "widespread" risk and the [most restrictions](#). According to the State's website, L.A. County reflects 10.1 new COVID-19 cases per day (per 100k), with an adjusted case rate for tier assignment equaling 7.6. The positivity rate is 3.4%; the health equity metric is 5.9% ([Healthy Places Index quartile positivity rate](#)). Los Angeles County has met the State's positivity rate metric threshold for Tier Three with "moderate" risk but remains in Tier One because the tier assignment case rate is greater than 7. When the positivity rate and case rate fall into different tiers, the stricter tier prevails. Below is a table that reflects each tier.
