Peck Reservoir Replacement Project

The Peck Reservoir Replacement project continues with its next activity involving construction of the onsite reservoir outlet pipe and drain piping.

It is anticipated that these tasks will be completed in March 2021.

Project Activity During Construction

- Complete the import, placement and compaction of the base rock subgrade material for reservoir and pump station building
- Layout, trench excavation and placement for the reservoir outlet and drain pipes
- Layout and construction of the west drain sump
- Backfill of construction trenching
- Delivery of material and heavy equipment – gravel, pipe, rebar, concrete and excavators

Impacts

- Limited noise from excavation trench activity
- Medium truck traffic on Peck Avenue during work hours
- Driveway access, trash and delivery services will not be affected
- PLEASE NOTE: circumstances such as weather may prolong these activities until they are completed

Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.
