COVID-19 Information

COVID-19, also known as coronvairus, is a virus that can result in a range of illnesses, from mild symptoms to severe illness and death. Older adults or people with certain medical conditions (like diabetes, heart disease, cancer, obesity) are more likely than others to become severly ill when infected. It's important to know steps you can take to stay healthy.

How to Prevent COVID-19.

- Wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose
- Avoid close contact with others. Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arm lengths) from other people.
- Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces.
- Wash hands often with soap and water.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.
- Get a COVID-19 vaccine.

Key Facts about COVID-19 Vaccination
Getting vaccinated can help prevent getting sick with
COVID-19. People who have already gotten sick with
COVID-19 may still benefit from getting vaccinated. The
vaccine cannot give you COVID-19 and it will not cause
you to test positive. The vaccinations are approved by
the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) and have been
held to the same safety standards as other routine
vaccines. The vaccinations are safe!
