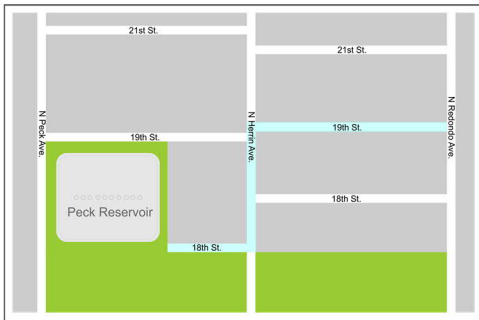

Peck Reservoir Replacement Project

June 30, 2021

The Peck Reservoir Replacement Project includes construction of offsite pipeline connections to the reservoir that includes a groundwater well pipeline, sewer line, vault and injection line. Prior to pipeline construction, survey and potholing activity is required to locate underground utilities.

It is anticipated that this work will be complete within one week or less.

Project Activity During Construction

- Construction signs to notify residents, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking restrictions
- Temporary parking restrictions and street impacts during potholing activity

Impacts

- Temporary parking and traffic impacts in work areas on 18th Street between the reservoir and Herrin Street, Herrin Street between 18th Street and 19th Street; and 19th Street just east of Herrin Street
- Residents will have access to driveways during work activity
- Through-traffic will be available at all times while potholing work activity occurs but may be temporarily delayed

Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.
