CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

 - o Second Dose Clinic: Thursday, September 2, 3:30PM to 5:30PM

Please note that only students who are currently 12 years old or older are eligible and parent/guardian must be present for student to be vaccinated. Types of identification that are accepted as proof of age include California ID card or REAL ID card, passport, birth certificate, or any official document that includes names and date of birth. - Safer Together, Get Your Free Vaccine Still need to get your COVID-19 vaccine? Getting the vaccine means moving towards a new, better, safer normal for you, your kids, and your community. And it has never been easier to get! Anyone 12 and older living or working in L.A. County can get vaccinated against COVID-19. Vaccinations are widely available throughout L.A. County and many sites are open on weekends and have evening hours. Vaccinations are always free and open to eligible residents. - Take the Beach Cities Health District Community Health Survey Beach Cities Health District (BCHD) is asking residents of Manhattan Beach to take its Community Health Survey to better understand local health needs. Residents are encouraged to fill out the survey to ensure their health needs are taken into consideration when BCHD determines its health priorities. The last day to complete the survey is Monday, August 30 and the survey takes 20 minutes to complete. Upon completion, you will have the option to enter an opportunity drawing for a chance to win two tickets to the Beach Life Festival or gift cards to Blue Zones Project Approved restaurants. • L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19 – The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) confirms 22 new deaths and 2,622 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 22 new deaths reported today, five people who passed away were over the age of 80, five people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, five people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64, five people died were between the ages of 30 and 49, and two people who died were between the ages of 18 and 29. To date, Public Health identified 1,331,859 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 24,805 deaths. Testing results are available for nearly 7,530,000 individuals with 16% of people testing positive. Today's test positivity rate is 4.6%. There are 1,503 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 23% of these people are in the ICU.
