COVID-19 Situation Report

CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- **Back to School Vaccine Clinic** – Beach Cities Health District will be hosting a back to school vaccine clinic for persons aged 12 years and older, school staff, and families at the South Bay Adult School located at 3401 Inglewood Avenue, Redondo Beach, 90278. Register [here](#) for the clinic where you will receive the Pfizer vaccine.
 - **First Dose Clinic:** Thursday, September 2, 3:30PM to 5:30PM
 - **Second Dose Clinic:** Thursday, September 23, 3:30PM to 5:30PMPlease note that only students who are currently 12 years old or older are eligible and parent/guardian must be present for student to be vaccinated. Types of identification that are accepted as proof of age include California ID card or REAL ID card, passport, birth certificate, or any official document that includes names and date of birth. - **Health Officer Order Updates** – The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has issued an updated Health Officer Order for youth sports leagues and Mega Events. **The update for youth sports leagues, which goes into effect tomorrow, Wednesday, September 1, 2021, includes the following:**
 - Youth sports leagues must follow the LA County [Health Officer Order](#) and the [LA County COVID19 Exposure Management Plan Guidance for Youth Recreational Sports Programs](#).
 - Youth sports leagues that employ coaches or other support staff must also adhere to the Cal/OSHA [COVID-19 Prevention Emergency Temporary Standards](#) (ETS).
 - Youth sports leagues operating concession stands should review and follow [DPH Best Practice Guidance for Food and Beverage Service](#).
 - **Participants:** When indoors, require all participants, regardless of vaccination status, [to bring and wear masks](#). Youth sports participants must wear a face mask even while engaging in physical activity in any indoor setting.
 - **Spectators:** When indoors, require all spectators, regardless of vaccination status, [to bring and wear masks](#). Make masks available for those who arrive without them.
 - **Coaches:** When indoors, require all coaches, regardless of vaccination status, [to bring and wear masks](#) when they are indoors. Coaches must wear masks even when engaged in intense physical activity when indoors.
- When outdoors, masks are recommended in crowded spaces and places, including among spectators at sporting events where distancing is not practical or possible. At sporting events attended by more than 10,000 individuals, universal masking is required by all spectators and employees except for the limited time when eating or drinking.

- L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19** – The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) confirms 33 new deaths and 1,938 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 33 new deaths reported today, 10 people who passed away were over the age of 80, four people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, 10 people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64, seven people who died were between the ages of 30 and 49, and one person who died was between the ages of 18 and 29. Two deaths were reported by the City of Long Beach. To date, Public Health identified 1,407,317 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 25,284 deaths. There are 1,709 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 26% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for nearly 8,122,000 individuals with 16% of people testing positive. Today’s test positivity rate is 2.5%, a decrease from last week’s same-day rate of 2.8%. This likely reflects the increases in routine screening testing, which occurs primarily among asymptomatic people.
