COVID-19 Situation Report

SEPTEMBER 14, 2021

CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- Manhattan Beach Residents are 85% Vaccinated 27,172 (83%) of Manhattan Beach residents, aged 12 years and up have received a COVID-19 vaccination as of September 9, 2021.
 L.A. County Department of Public Health has reported 3,283 residents aged 12 17 years and 23,889 residents aged 18 and older have received at least one dose of the vaccine. For more information, visit L.A. County Department of Public Health's Data Dashboard.
- LA County Experiences 50% Decrease in COVID-19 Case Rate from August Peak As of September 10, 2021, Los Angeles County's 7-day cumulative case rate decreased 35% from the week of August 30, 2021 to 104 new cases per 100,000 residents. This marks the third week in a row of decreases in the County's case rate. Overall, the County has seen a 50% decrease from the peak of 204 cases per 100,000 on August 19, 2021.
- Los Angeles County Health Officer Order on Youth Sports- The County continues to recommend weekly testing for unvaccinated participants in youth sports. The following applies to teams and sport activities based in Los Angeles County and relaxes some screening testing:
 - o Indoor Moderate or High Risk Sports for children of all ages, staff, coaches and volunteers. A weekly negative test result is required for all participants who are not fully vaccinated, including children who are playing, staff, coaches and volunteers; weekly school testing fulfills this obligation.
 - Outdoor Moderate or High Risk Sports for youth 12 and older, staff, coaches and volunteers. A weekly negative test result is required for all participants 12 and older who are not fully vaccinated, including children who are playing, staff, coaches and volunteers; weekly school testing fulfills this obligation.
 - o No screening testing required for children under 12 playing Outdoor Sports; weekly school testing fulfills this recommendation.
 - Fully vaccinated youth participating in outdoor sports are not required to test weekly unless there is a positive case among players, coaches and/or staff. If there is a positive case, all players, coaches, staff and volunteers (regardless of vaccination status) are required to have a weekly negative test result for two weeks from exposure to the case and must test negative prior to competitions.

These requirements may be modified based on the availability of and access to testing and will be reassessed when community transmission is no longer high. Please visit <u>County of Los</u>

- L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19 Public Health confirms 27 new deaths and 1,725 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 27 new deaths reported today, five people who passed away were over the age of 80, 10 people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, nine people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64, and three people who died were between the ages of 30 and 49. To date, Public Health identified 1,435,163 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 25,713 deaths. There are 1,224 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 30% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for nearly 8,400,000 individuals with 16% of people testing positive.
