COVID-19 Situation Report

SEPTEMBER 16, 2021

CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- Case Rates Decline 40% Among Youth over the Last Three Weeks While case rates increased among children in all age groups between mid-July and mid-August, over the last three weeks, cases declined in all children age groups by 40%. The current case rate for 12 to 17 year-olds is 132 new cases per 100,000 teens; for 5 to 11 year-olds the case rate is now 141 new cases per 100,000 children; and for children 0 to 4, the case rate is 88 per 100,000 children. With most of the 1.5 million children in grades K-12 now having returned to in-person instruction, Public Health is encouraged that case rates have not increased. The decreases are similar to the decreases seen among adult residents and occurred as many schools reopened with testing, masking, infection control, and outbreak management protocols in place. - Los Angeles County Health Officer Order Update- Public Health will be modifying the Health Officer Order on October 7, 2021 to increase vaccination coverage in Los Angeles County, requiring verification of vaccination in select high-risk settings. The modifications, which are expected later this week, will require vaccination verification or a negative test within 72 hours prior to attending outdoor mega events. Attendees at indoor mega events are already required to show proof of vaccination or a negative test results prior to entry. Vaccine verification will also be required for customers and employees at indoor portions of bars, wineries, breweries, night clubs, and lounges. These establishments are primarily attended by adults and already require patrons to show identification. The modified Health Officer Order will require customers and employees at bars, breweries, wineries, night clubs, and lounges to have at least one dose of the vaccine by October 7, 2021 and both doses by November 4, 2021. • L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19 - Public Health confirms 28 new deaths and 2,023 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 28 new deaths reported today, four people who passed away were over the age of 80, six people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, eight people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64, eight people who died were between the ages of 30 and 49, and one person who died was between the ages of 18 and 29. One death was reported by the City of Pasadena. To date, Public Health identified 1,439,011 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 25,775 deaths. There are 1,185 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 30% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for more than 8,414,000 individuals with 16% of people testing positive. Today's test positivity rate is 1.6%.
