COVID-19 Situation Report

CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- **City of Manhattan Beach Announces Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination for its Employees** - After careful consideration, at its meeting on September 21, 2021, the City Council voted to require all City employees to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 by December 1, 2021. This vote comes after August 23, 2021, when the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) provided full approval of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. - **Los Angeles County Health Officer Order Update** - Public Health has modified the [Health Officer Order](#) requiring customers and employees at bars, breweries, wineries, nightclubs, and lounges to have at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by October 7 and both doses by November 4, 2021. Vaccine verification or a negative COVID-19 test result within 72 hours will also be required for those attending outdoor mega events (10,000 persons or more). Attendees at indoor mega events are already required to show proof of vaccination or a negative test results prior to entry. - **L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19** - Public Health confirms 32 new deaths and 1,900 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 32 new deaths reported today, seven people who passed away were over the age of 80, 13 people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, and 11 people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64. One death was reported by the City of Long Beach. To date, Public Health identified 1,449,923 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 25,942 deaths. There are 991 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 31% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for nearly 8,530,000 individuals with 16% of people testing positive.
