The Board of Trustees of the City of Manhattan Beach do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1-It is hereby declared unlawful for any person to dress or undress or disrobe or change clothing or to change from ordinary wearing apparel to a bathing suit, in any automobile or any other vehicle or conveyance on any public street, avenue, lane or alley, or in any public place in the City of Manhattan Beach.

dress or undress or disrobe or change clothing or to change from ordinary wearing apparel to a bathing suit in any tent or tent house or umbrella tent or any temporary structure of any kind or nature on the beach, or which is placed or erected in any portion of the City of Manhattan Beach westerly of the Pacific Plectric Railway Company right of way.

bathing suit or bathing costume to appear upon the municipal wharf or on any public street, avenue, lane, alley or other public place in the City of Manhattan Beach, except on the beach or that portion of said City westerly of the Pacific Electric Railway Company right of way, except such person is wearing over such bathing suit or costume a coat, shawl or other covering which completely clothes or covers the body of such person from the shoulders to the images.

SECTION 4-any person violating any portion of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall

be punishable by a fine not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not exceeding nine-ty (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
