AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE ACQUISITION BY CONDEMNATION, FOR PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES, OF BLOCKS FIVE (5) AND TWELVE (12) OF PECK'S MANHATTAN BEACH TRACT, IN THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, IN THE MANNER CONTEMPLATED BY ORDINANCE NO. 276.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Manhattan Beach do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1-That the public interest and convenience require, and it is hereby found and determined that the public interest and necessity require, and the Board of Trustees of the City of Manhattan Beach does hereby order the following improvement to be made, to-wit:

That Blocks Five (5) and Twelve (12) of Peck's Manhattan Beach Tract, in the City of Manhattan Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map thereof recorded in Map Book 7, at page 34 in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County, be acquired by condemnation for public park purposes, in the manner contemplated by Ordinance No. 276 of said City, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH TO ACQUIRE BY CONDEMNATION FOR PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES, BLOCKS FIVE (5) AND TWELVE (12) OF PECK'S MANHATTAN BEACH TRACT, IN SAID CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH; DESCRIBING THE LAND NECESSARY TO BE TAKEN THEREFOR AND DESCRIBING THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT TO BE BENEFITED BY THE ACQUISITION OF SUCH LAND AND TO BE ASSESSED TO PAY THE DAMAGES AND COSTS OF SUCH ACQUISITION AND TO BE KNOWN AS THE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 263" passed and adopted and approved June 19th, 1924, to which said Ordinance reference is hereby made for all particulars regarding said improvement.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Manhattan Beach do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1-That the public interest and convenience require, and it is hereby found and determined that the public interest and necessity and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Manhattan Beach to order the following improvement to be made, to-wit:

That Blocks Five (5) and Twelve (12) of Peck's Manhattan Beach Tract in the City of Manhattan Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map thereof recorded in Map Book 7 at page 34 in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County, be acquired by condemnation for public park purposes.

SECTION 2-That the land necessary and convenient to be taken for public park purposes as described in Section 1 hereof, is situated in the City of Manhattan Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Lots One to Fourteen (1 to 14) inclusive of Block Five (5) and Lots One to Sixteen (1 to 16) inclusive of Block Twelve (12) of Peck's Manhattan Beach Tract, as per map thereof recorded in Map Book 7 at page 34, in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County.

SECTION 3-That the exterior boundaries of the district in the City of Manhattan Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to be benefited by the acquisition of such land and to be assessed

1 to pay the damages and costs of such acquisition and to be known as
2 the assessment district, are hereby fixed and described as follows,
3 to-wit:

4 Beginning at the point of intersection of the mean
5 high tide line of the Pacific Ocean with the northerly
6 boundary line of the City of Manhattan Beach; thence south-
7 erly along the mean high tide line of the Pacific Ocean to
8 the point of intersection with the southerly boundary line
9 of said City of Manhattan Beach; thence easterly along the
10 southerly boundary line of said city to the southeast cor-
11 ner of said city; thence northerly along the easterly boun-
12 dary line of said city to the northeast corner thereof;
13 thence westerly along the northerly boundary line of said
14 city to the point of beginning; excepting therefrom any
15 portion of any public street or alley or public place in-

17 made against any land included in said assessment district
18 not legally assessable.

19 Reference is hereby made to a Plat or Map of such Assessment
20 District designated as Diagram No. 3060P for further information
21 as to the extent of the territory to be included in said Assessment
22 District, approved by the Board of Trustees of said City this 19th
23 day of June, 1924, and which is on file in the office of the City
24 Engineer of said City.

25 SECTION 4-That the proceedings for the aforesaid improvement
26 shall be had and taken under the "Park and Playground Act of 1909",
27 and the Street Superintendent of the City of Manhattan Beach shall
28 post and publish notices of said improvement in the manner and for
29 the time required by said Act, and the Manhattan Beach News, a week-
30 ly newspaper published and circulated in said City is hereby desig-
31 nated as the newspaper in which said notice shall be published; and,
32 furthermore, it is by said Board of Trustees determined and ordain-
ed that improvement bonds may issue to represent the assessment for
said improvement in conformity to and under the provisions of, and
in accordance with the requirements of an Act of the Legislature of
the State of California, approved April 27th 1911, entitled, "An
Act Providing for the Issuance of Improvement Bonds to Represent Cer-
tain Special Assessments For Public Improvement, And Providing For The

1 Effect and Enforcement of Such Bonds"; and under all acts supple-
2 mentary or amendatory thereof.

3 SECTION 5-That Ordinance No. 263 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE DE-
4 CLARING THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF MAN-
5 HATTAN BEACH TO ACQUIRE BY CONDEMNATION FOR PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES,
6 BLOCKS FIVE (5) AND TWELVE (12) OF PECK'S MANHATTAN BEACH TRACT,
