COVID-19 CASE COUNT OCTOBER 5, 2021

The City of Manhattan Beach remains committed to providing the community with critical information and updates on the COVID-19 pandemic. The COVID-19 Situation Reports are published once-a-week on Thursdays and are supplemented with coronavirus Case Counts (latest numbers) on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to keep the community informed. In an effort to find a balanced approach to disseminating COVID-19 updates to the community, staff is reviewing the analytics, email comments and general feedback about the frequency and email lists for news on the Coronavirus.
