# COVID-19 Situation Report

OCTOBER 14, 2021

## CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- **Manhattan Beach Residents are 87% Vaccinated** – 27,768 (87.2%) of Manhattan Beach residents, aged 12 years and up have received a COVID-19 vaccination as of October 7, 2021. L.A. County Department of Public Health has reported 2,907 residents aged 12 – 17 years and 24,861 residents aged 18 and older have received at least one dose of the vaccine. - **Flu Shot Clinic** – The City of Manhattan Beach is hosting a free flu shot clinic provided by the Los Angeles County Department of Health and the Older Adults Program. - **Beach Cities Health District (BCHD) Booster Vaccine Clinic for Older Adults** – The City of Manhattan Beach in partnership with Beach Cities Health District and the County of Los Angeles Public Health Department is offering a Pfizer Booster Vaccine Clinic for older adults ages 65+ on Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at the Joslyn Community Center from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. - **L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19** – Public Health confirms 19 new deaths and 1,142 new cases of COVID-19. Of the 19 new deaths reported today, seven people who passed away were over the age of 80, two people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, three people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64, and seven people who died were between the ages of 30 and 49. To date, Public Health has identified 1,474,518 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 26,372 deaths. There are 698 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized and 28% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for nearly 8,833,000 individuals with 15% of people testing positive.
