CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- **Who is Eligible for a COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Shot** – COVID-19 Vaccine booster shots are available for the following Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine recipients who completed their initial series at least 6 months ago and are:
 - 65 years and older
 - Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
 - Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
 - Age 18+ who work in high-risk settings
 - Age 18+ who live in high-risk settings

- **Guidance for Families and Individuals to Have a Spooky and COVID-SAFE Halloween** – When planning your Halloween activities, think about your and your family's level of risk and remember where COVID-19 spreads more easily:
 - Closed spaces with poor air flow
 - Crowded places with many people nearby
 - Close contact settings especially where people are talking, laughing, screaming, or breathing heavily close together.

- **Public Health Urges Everyone to View or Attend Sports Events Safely** – The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) urges everyone viewing or attending sports events to do so safely. The best way to enjoy viewing or attending sports events safely is to be vaccinated, masked up, and prepared to comply with public health directives. - **L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19** – Public Health confirms 27 new deaths and 1,167 new cases. Of the 27 new deaths reported today, seven people who passed away were over the age of 80, two people who died were between the ages of 65 and 79, eight people who died were between the ages of 50 and 64 and four people who died were between the ages of 30 and 49. Six deaths were reported by the City of Long Beach. To date, Public Health has identified 1,481,814 positive cases of COVID-19 across all areas of L.A. County and a total of 26,499 deaths. There are 613 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized, and 29% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for more than 8,940,000 individuals with 15% of people testing positive. Today's test positivity rate is 0.9%. To view Statewide case
