## **COVID-19 Situation Report**

**DECEMBER 2, 2021**

### **CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES**

- **As Omicron is Detected in California, Public Health Urges Everyone to Take Action -** Vaccines remain the most effective tool and the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) encourages everyone 5 and older not yet vaccinated or boosted to do so with a sense of urgency. The vaccines are effective against the Delta variant and very effective against earlier strains of the virus, which gives us hope that these same vaccines will also provide some protection against Omicron. - **Guidance for Hosting Winter Holiday Events -** The winter holidays are a time for joyous celebrations, family get-togethers, and beloved seasonal traditions. This guide for businesses and venues outlines steps to help reduce the risk of COVID-19 while hosting winter holiday events. COVID-19 continues to circulate in LA County due to the highly infectious Delta variant, and everyone must take steps to reduce risk, especially during the winter season. - **L.A. County Daily Briefing Statistics on COVID-19 –** Public Health confirmed 24 new deaths and 1,970 new cases of COVID-19. There are 574 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized, 27% of these people are in the ICU. Testing results are available for nearly 9,448,000 individuals, with 15% of people testing positive.
