HEALTH OFFICER ORDER UPDATE

The Los Angeles County Responding Together at Work and in the Community [Health Officer Order](#) (HOO) has been updated. Please note that the updated definitions for mega events are effective as of 1/15/22 and the masking requirement is effective no later than 1/17/22. Changes to the HOO are highlighted below:

- Isolation and Quarantine Requirements are revised to mainly align with the State Public Health Officer’s revised [Guidance for Local Health Jurisdictions on Isolation and Quarantine for the General Public](#), released on January 8, 2022. This guidance does NOT apply to healthcare personnel in any setting or emergency services personnel. See [AFL-21-08.7](#). This guidance does NOT apply to TK – 12 Schools. See Appendix T1 & T2. In the workplace, employers are subject to the [Cal/OSHA COVID-19 Prevention Emergency Standards \(ETS\)](#) or in some workplaces the [Cal/OSHA Aerosol Transmission Diseases \(ATD\) Standard](#) (PDF), and should consult those regulations for additional applicable requirements.
