COUNTY LIFTS INDOOR MASK REQUIREMENT

Effective today, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has modified the [Health Officer Order](#). Under this modified order indoor masking is strongly recommended, but not required, for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals in most indoor settings with the exception of some high-risk settings.

As such, masks are optional when visiting City Hall and other City facilities, including the Police and Fire Department lobby, community centers, and the Manhattan Beach Art Center. The City of Manhattan Beach remains committed to providing the community with critical information and updates on the COVID-19 pandemic. The COVID-19 Situation Reports are published once-a-week on Thursdays and are supplemented with coronavirus Case Counts (latest numbers) on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to keep the community informed.
