Peck Reservoir Replacement Project

The Peck Reservoir Replacement Project continues to make progress and the team is preparing for an upcoming concrete pour within the reservoir site. While the concrete pour will be performed during normal work hours, some personnel will be on site until approximately 6:00 p.m. on Friday, April 8, to finish the concrete process.

It is anticipated that the concrete pour will be complete within one workday, while curing will continue throughout the following week. The curing process is not expected to impact neighboring community members. Personnel may be on site intermittently over the weekend to continue to finish the concrete work.

Impacts

- Personnel on site during non-work hours (Friday and weekend) to monitor concrete curing process
- No major construction activity expected while monitoring concrete cure

Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.
