### CURRENT INITIATIVES AND UPDATES

- MANHATTAN BEACH LIBRARY VACCINE CLINIC** - L.A. County Department of Public Health is partnering with L.A. County Library to provide free COVID-19 vaccines to people 12 and over, no health insurance required on Wednesday, April 27, 2022, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Manhattan Beach Library. - L.A. COUNTY DAILY BRIEFING STATISTICS ON COVID-19** – L.A. Public Health confirmed 15 additional deaths and 1,088 new cases of COVID-19. Today’s positivity rate is 1.0%. There are 273 people with COVID-19 currently hospitalized. Testing results are available for more than 11,737,000 individuals, with 22% of people testing positive.
