HISTORY & BACKGROUND

- Current facility constructed in the 1950s by the Boy Scouts and donated to the City of Manhattan Beach
- 2013 The Friends of the Senior and Scout Community Center formed
- 2014 The City, Friends, and the Manhattan Beach Property Owners Association entered into an MOU

HISTORY & BACKGROUND

- August, 2018 City Council directed staff to begin negotiations for the construction of the new facility
- October, 2018 City Council allocated \$1.0 million toward construction of the new facility
- The anticipated cost of construction, including both interior and exterior design elements, were estimated to range from \$3.1 to \$3.7 million for the approximately 7,000 square foot facility

MOU DETAILS

- Building Design 7,000 square feet of multi-use space
- Facility Use
 - Scouts
 - 3:00 p.m. weekdays (Wednesday 1:30 p.m.) until 10:00 p.m.
 - Weekends 24 hours (use permit required)
 - Older Adults
 - 9:00 a.m. 2:30 p.m. weekdays (Wednesdays until 1:00 p.m.
 - 1,000 sq. ft. dedicated for exclusive use
 - Community Reservations
 - 30 days in advance (no less than 10 days)
 - Facility fees and regulations apply (no alcohol)



MOU DETAILS

- Project
 - Permits
 - Plan review 35%, 65%, 95%, 100%
 - California Environmental Quality Act Review Local Coastal Plan Compliance
- Timeline
 - Estimated completion 2025
- Public Outreach
 - City Council meetings
 - Community meetings
 - Noticing (1,000 ft.)
 - Participation/feedback

MOU DETAILS

- Naming Rights
 - Subject to final City Council approval (except for bricks and plaques)
 - MBPOA for Older Adult space
 - BCHD for kitchen and community room
- Termination
 - Friends 2 year construction commitment
 - City funding deposit
- Contribution Agreements
 - Manhattan Beach Property Owners (MBPOA)
 - Beach Cities Health District (BCHD)
 - Sandpipers



FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 2014 MOU developed a path to a Senior and Scout Community Center
 - The City, Friends, and Manhattan Beach Property Owners
- 2018 City commitment of \$1M
- 2019 Development and Disposition Agreement (DDA)
 - Anticipated costs ranged from \$3.1 to \$3.7
 - City constructs shell, Friends interior
- 2020 Decision for City to manage construction
 - MOU developed



FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- Project costs increased significantly
 - Market, COVID, supply chain
- Project costs \$5,189,540
- Friends contributions \$3,290,000 (includes \$1.0 Million)
 - Friends funds committed/expended to date \$290,000
- Additional funds needed \$1,899,540
- 15% Contingency included
 - Balance returned to City if unused
