Dogs 4 months or older residing in the City for more than 30 days are required to be licensed. (M.B.M.C. 5.01.140).

RABIES VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS:

Proof of a valid vaccination is required in order for a license to be issued.

MUST NOT EXPIRE BEFORE 8/31/2024*

*Except for initial 1-year immunizations.

LICENSING PRICES:

Sterile Animal (with proof): **\$22**

Intact Animal: **\$50**

Replacement Tag: **\$4**
