RECOMMENDATIONS

Reduce Attractants

- Wildlife-proof trash receptacles
- Prevent overflowing trash

- Reduce rodent harborage
- Prohibit feeding of wildlife

- Adopt a feral cat management plan
- Improve handling of stray cats

- Dedicated Canid Response Unit
- Education, education, education

- Adopt a canid response plan
