Hi Paul,

You are smart to take nothing for granted.

- 1. This date is the earliest I can add an item to the agenda. I wanted to have the stop sign installed as soon as possible after school starts this fall.
- 2. The possible outcomes are: a) automatic approval on consent, b) item pulled and discussed and approved individually, c) item pulled and discussed and continued, or d) item pulled and discussed and referred back to PPIC (not likely).
- 3. The installation time would probably be 2-4 weeks after approval, because the old markings need to be removed by grinding, and new STOP markings installed by our subcontractor.
- 4. The new stop signs will have big orange flags mounted above them so drivers will notice the change. We will also place stop signs at the centerline on barricades for extra driver awareness for a few months.

Hi Erik.

Needless to say we were all very pleased with the outcome of last night's PPIC meeting. Many thanks to you and Fel for your cooperation, assistance and responsiveness throughout the process to date.

However, I had forgotten that the September 20<sup>th</sup> City Council sign-off is required before things can proceed with installation of our 4-way stop. Though City Council's final approval should be perfunctory, I take nothing for granted.

A couple of questions as the process continues:

- 1) Is there any way the date of our 4-way stop final approval by Council could be moved to the Consent Calendar for another date, before or after September 20<sup>th</sup> ... other than being moved to a later date at the September 20<sup>th</sup> meeting by Council intervention?
- 2) What could happen at the September 20<sup>th</sup> Council meeting other than a default approval of our 4-way stop by Council's approval of the Consent Calendar?
  - o I see that a single Council Member can pull an item from the Consent Calendar for "individual consideration".
  - What are the possible outcomes of this "individual consideration" ... could the Council reject our 4-way stop and/or send it back to PPIC for further review?
- 3) Assuming that Council approves our 4-way stop on September 20<sup>th</sup>, how long does it typically take to have such a 4-way stop installed?
  - As you can see from the attached slide I didn't use last night, the Martyrs and Pacific elementary schools and pre-schools all start for the 2022/23 school year in less than a month.
- 4) When new stop signs are first installed (such as the two that will be installed on Pacific as part of our 4-way stop), what is typically done to alert drivers of the new stop sign?
  - o It would be nice to have flashing lights around the new stop signs like the stop signs immediately around Pacific and Martyrs elementary schools.







City Council Members,

The purpose of this email is twofold: to call your attention to the brazen and accelerating anti-Semitic climate in our beloved Manhattan Beach, and to ask for the City's FORMAL support of our diverse Jewish community during tomorrow's City Council Meeting at 6 pm.

Please see the attached photo, which was taken this weekend. I already submitted this image to the MBPD, and flagged it to the ADL, but wanted to put it on your radar as well. It is relevant not only due to the rising anti-Semitic activity in our town, but also the recent vandalism at MBUSD campuses. These symbols are derivative, divisive and immediately spark discomfort. After submitting the picture to the ADL last night, they quickly opined that the red around the swastika neither negates or reinforces the image, it is what it is: a swastika. It also clarified that the 88 is just as problematic. The 8th letter in the alphabet is H, so 88 equates to HH, or Heil Hitler. It is disgusting that this type of hate is openly displayed in our community.

I know that there are pressing Fire Department issues on the docket tomorrow, but I would like to have the MB City Council publicly come out in support of the Jewish Community and formally acknowledge the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance's (IHRA) definition of Anti-Semitism.

Given the widespread adoption of this definition worldwide, perhaps Council thought it had already been done, or it was a foregone conclusion? It is not. And we need your help now. I urge you to add this item to the agenda tomorrow and formally acknowledge the IHRA's definition of Anti-Semitism. This hate must be addressed now. It cannot continue to fester. With your leadership, Manhattan Beach can unequivocally denounce anti-Semitism and actively support our Jewish community.

Quite frankly it is ridiculous for such a small fire department to hire outside battalion chiefs or even a fire chief. It is a morale killer. It would seem your previous battalion chiefs and your Chiefs elections are just looking for a big second retirement check so by the time they might be able to make a change they are punching out. It would also seem there's a lot of misleading arguments about they make so much money when the overtime is forced and these guys are miserable missing time away from their families. Not to mention once you were up for 16 hours your decision making and reaction times are the same or worse than being legally drunk. It is completely irresponsible for them to be so short staffed and have vacancies, and for you to take other positions that will not be firefighter positions anymore further making the staffing tighter.
