

Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.

The Peck Reservoir Replacement Project offsite pipeline work continues with the installation of a 6'x6' injection line vault and a 2-inch injection line conduit. These activities are anticipated to be the final offsite work needed for this project. The contractor will begin working from the southern point on Herrin Avenue and will continue activities north on Herrin Avenue and east onto 19th Street.

Project Activity During Construction

Construction signs to notify residents, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking restrictions.

- Temporary closure of the intersection at 19th Street/Herrin Avenue during work hours driveway access available at all times with flagmen to assist
- Trench excavation and installation of pipeline and underground vault on 19th Street
- Temporary parking restrictions and street closure in and around work area during work hours
- Delivery of material and use of heavy equipment pipes, excavator, backhoe, delivery trucks

Impacts

- No through-traffic 19th Street (local access will be provided to residents on 19th Street with flagmen to assist)
- Intermittent truck activity on Herrin Avenue, 19th Street and Redondo Avenue during work hours
- Immediate work area will be cordoned off
- Intersection and through-traffic will have access to 19th Street and Herrin Avenue before and after work hours
