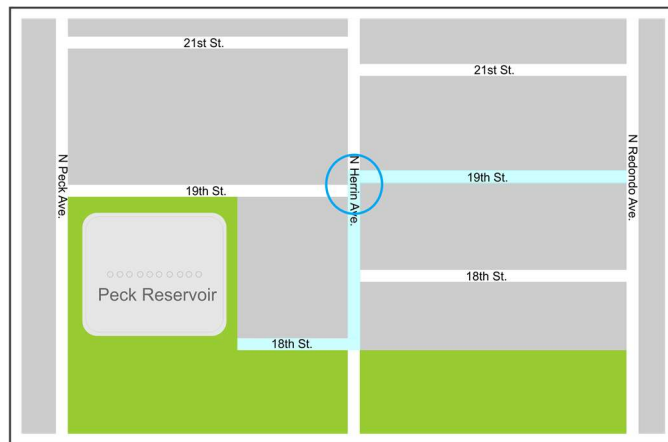

Peck Reservoir Replacement Project

### Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.

The Peck Reservoir Replacement Project offsite pipeline work continues with the trench installation of a 2-inch injection line conduit connecting the installed vaults, and flushing and disinfection of the new well water transmission pipeline. These activities are anticipated to be the final offsite work needed for this project. With this work currently ongoing, the contractor now anticipates being completed by **Friday, November 18, 2022**.

The map below shows the work areas, highlighted in blue:



### Project Activity During Construction

Construction signs to notify residents, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking restrictions through **November 18, 2022**:

- **Temporary closure of the intersection at 19<sup>th</sup> Street/Herrin Avenue during work hours** – driveway access available at all times with flagmen to assist
- Trench excavation and installation of pipeline and underground vault on 19<sup>th</sup> Street
- Temporary parking restrictions and street closure in and around work area during work hours
- Delivery of material and use of heavy equipment – pipes, excavator, backhoe, delivery trucks

### Impacts

- No through-traffic 19<sup>th</sup> Street (local access will be provided to residents on 19<sup>th</sup> Street with flagmen to assist)
- Intermittent truck activity on Herrin Avenue, 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Redondo Avenue during work hours
- Immediate work area will be cordoned off
- Intersection and through-traffic will have access to 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Herrin Avenue before and after work hours
