Peck Reservoir Replacement Project

The Peck Reservoir Replacement Project team is continuing with their backfilling activities and are now prepared to haul out excess soil away from the project site. Haul trucks will enter the project site via Peck Avenue to collect the excess soil, and once filled, the trucks will exit via Peck Avenue to Marine Avenue only. No other residential streets will be utilized for this activity.

Future soil export truck hauling dates are anticipated, and we will provide you with notices for these planned activities once confirmed.

This activity is an important undertaking towards the full completion of the reservoir and its facilities.

### Impacts

- Temporary “No Parking” restrictions will be in place on the west side of Peck Avenue, from Marine Avenue to 21<sup>st</sup> Street, during work hours
- Dust control will be used on Peck Avenue
- Vibration is not anticipated for these activities

### Background

The Peck Reservoir Facility, built in 1957, was identified as a top priority and recommended to be replaced as part of the 2010 Water System Master Plan. The new Peck Reservoir will increase its capacity to eight million gallons and include new state-of-the-art filtration and other equipment to serve the Manhattan Beach community for the next 75 years and help ensure the long-term dependability of the water system in the community.
