City Council Adjourned Regular Meeting
Tuesday, March 22, 2022 4:30 PM

Mayor Stern: Thank you. Well welcome everyone to our City Council Adjourned Regular Meeting of Tuesday, March 22, 2022. We will begin tonight with our Closed Session at 4:30 PM. So I will call this meeting to order and our first line of business is to join together in saying the Pledge of Allegiance. So I will ask if you could rise to the level that you are able and we will say the Pledge together.

All: I pledge allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands, one Nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all.

Mayor Stern: Ok, we will move on to Item C, which is our roll call. And I will turn this over to City Clerk Tamura to conduct the roll call.

Councilmember Franklin: Here.

Councilmember Hadley: Here.

Mayor Pro Tem Napolitano: Here.

City Clerk Tamura: Mayor Stern.

Mayor Stern: I am here.

Mayor Stern: Thank you. We will move on to Item D, which is our Public Comments and I will ask Assistant City Clerk Alvarez if anybody would like to make public comments at this time.

Assistant City Clerk Alvarez: There's no request for Public Comments at this time.

Mayor Stern: Ok, we're moving along to Item E which is our Closed Session and I will turn this over to City Attorney Barrow to make our announcement in Open Session of items to be discussed in Closed Session.

City Attorney Barrow: Thank you, Mayor. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 54957.6 and 54956.9(d)(2)(e)(5) the City Council will now go into Closed Session to discuss the items identified on the agenda.

Mayor Stern: Thank you. So we will recess into Closed Session and we will reconvene at 6:00 PM here for back into Open Session after our Closed Session.
