Mayor Stern: Well, thank you. Welcome everyone to our Thursday, May 12, 2022 City Council Adjourned Regular Meeting. This is a Zoom meeting. And I will start our meeting by our usual Pledge to the Flag. So I will ask everyone if they could rise to the level that they are able and we will join together in the Pledge.
