



Overall Sentiment





My main concern at this point focuses on Exhibit A, Scope of Services, Task 2 - Community Engagement in the Agreement. Under Task 2, only two meetings are specified. This does not seem sufficient for a project of this size. HMC's proposal sounds good, "To develop a comprehensive conceptual design with overwhelming community support, it is critical to understand their needs and desires" but the implementation seems lacking. What are the chances that all of the interested community members will be available at the same time to participate in, "a visioning and programming exercise" "to help determine this facility's aspirations and guiding principles" that will allow "the community to inspire and guide our team to create a design that best represents their goals as users". A more robust community engagement process with diverse opportunities for community input will provide better guidance for the design team. I don't have a need to "feel heard". I want to actually be heard.


