What is the purpose of the Outdoor Dining Program?

During the COVID-19 pandemic recovery, the City permitted businesses to use parking spaces and street areas in the public right-of-way during COVID-19 operating restrictions through various Emergency Orders. The purpose of this current project is to study and propose a long-term solution which may allow some of these operations to return while ensuring that fiscal, environmental, parking, and other impacts are all accounted for before a long-term program is implemented.
